READING

We have officially jumped into our nonfiction unit! Students had the chance to explore nonfiction texts, learn more about types of text features & how they help the reader, and learn how to identify main idea & supporting details.

Reminder: Unit 1 (Part 2) Reading Assessment feedback came home on January 29th.

WRITING

Students are finalizing their research and are beginning to turn their notes into sentences & paragraphs. We have been learning HOW to transition from bullet points to a complete sentence and keeping track of the notes we end up adding to the informational piece. Students will have a few days to draft before we begin working on specific techniques & next steps.



MATH

We are wrapping up Module 2! Students have been working with two digit divisors, dividing out to the decimal point (no remainder), and solving word problems involving decimal division. We will review for the end of module next week and then take the assessment once we return from break!

- Investigating & modeling emulsifiers


Ask your kiddo what an emulsifier is!
