READING

In reading, we are learning strategies to navigate through complex nonfiction texts. We have learned how to determine unknown vocabulary words through context clues and morphology (prefixes, roots, & suffixes). On Thursday, we practiced persevering through misleading titles and headings. Next, we're jumping into learning about the different nonfiction text structures!

WRITING

Now that students have had a little time to draft, we are starting to learn specific writing techniques to add to our informational pieces! We have learned about writing in a formal voice and how to intentionally use the formatting tools in Microsoft Word. I am conferencing with students each day to specifically look at strengths & things to work on in their individual writing pieces.


