In reading, we spent some time learning about and identifying the different text structures of informational text. We then learned & utilized strategies to help us rise to the challenge when nonfiction text gets tricky. We are now working on learning how to summarize and will continue practicing next week!

This could be by defining the word in the sentence or adding it to the glossary at the end!
