READING

We have been focusing on thinking analytically about our reading! Students have been practicing writing reading responses with more of their own thinking about what they read. We are honing in on story elements to pay attention to, finding text evidence to support ideas, and goal setting to grow as readers this year!

WRITING

Our first writing unit & writing piece will be Narrative Writing. Students were able to see completed samples from past students and also began brainstorming possible topics. Before we jumped into narratives, we reviewed conventions like capitalization, punctuation, and verb tenses to set us up for success once we start drafting!





MATH

We are working through Module 1 in math! This module focuses heavily on place value. We have been working on place value, multiplying & dividing by base 10 numbers, using base 10 exponents, and making metric conversions.

<u>Social Studies - First People, Encounter, &</u> <u>Colonization</u>

We have launched our first social studies unit! So far we have learned about:

- Natural resources used by the first people
- Reasons Europeans came to North America
- The Columbus encounter from both the Columbus & first people perspective
- Gains & losses of the indigenous people & Europeans

SOCIAL EMOTIONAL LEARNING

In 2nd Step, we have learned about Empathy & Respect and Listening with Attention.
